



Curriculum statement

Geography

GCSE: Students follow the AQA route.

The AQA course is well resourced, including text books and kerboodle for consolidation. The course offers a breadth of coverage in physical, human and environmental geography. It considers social, environmental, political and economic impacts of events and actions. It also offers opportunities for field trips, which engages students and supports in developing practical skills. Assessment is based on exam-pro, specimen and past papers. Attainment is recorded using AQA boundaries from the previous years.

A small cohort of students are offered Level 2 BTEC Travel and Tourism rather than GCSE Geography. This is to support their interest in Geography themes, but give them a vocational route to ensure their success at KS4.
